

Placerita Canyon Park Rules

Visitors must stay on the trails. This is for the safety of hikers as well as the conservation and maintenance of the park. There are potentially harmful snakes, ticks, poison oak and obstructions found off trail. The hike leader may give permission to go off the trail in a limited, designated area for a short, monitored period.

Visitors may roam off the trails in the day use areas, which are the areas immediately around the Nature Center, the parking areas, the stream adjacent to the main parking lot, the picnic area, and directly around the Walker Cabin.

No picking, digging up, and collecting of plants and their parts, mushrooms, rocks or insects is allowed. The hike leader may pick a part of a plant, a rock or an insect for demonstration purposes only.

No feeding the wildlife in the park.

Nothing that comes from the park can be taken out of the park.
